Mentoring, Counselling and Peer Support Programs for Students, Faculty and Staff

One of the services being offered by the Student Welfare Unit under the Office of Student Affairs and Services (OSAS) of the University is Guidance and Counselling Services. Guidance services use an integrated approach to the development of well-functioning individuals primarily by helping them to utilize their potentials to the fullest. Counseling services are individual and/or group interventions designed to facilitate positive change in student behavior, feelings, and attitudes. These services include mentoring, counselling, or peer support activities to support all students including those from underrepresented groups.

In 2023, the University conducts Guidance and Counseling Information Drive, Group Guidance Program and Mental Health Activities, “Kamustahan” Program and Career Guidance activities.

In addition, to promote a more inclusive campus environment, the MMSU College of Health Sciences (CHS) organized a disability sensitivity training for teaching and non-teaching personnel of the university. The program dubbed IGNITE and DISCOVER was conducted in line with the National Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation (NDPR) month celebration. IGNITE stands for Innovative Gathering for Nurturing Inclusive Teaching Environments, while DISCOVER means Disability Inclusion Strategies, Concepts, Outputs, Valuable Experiences and Researches.

Committed to champion social justice and human rights, Mariano Marcos State University launched an awareness campaign on its Equal Opportunity Policy (EOP) and Rules on Anti-Sexual Harassment (ASH). It was attended by the MMSU faculty and staff, and other stakeholders such as local government and barangay officials, police officers, legal officers, guidance counselors, tricycle operators and drivers, and dormitory supervisors in Batac City.
