Events for Local Farmers and Food Producers

Mariano Marcos State University (MMSU) organizes various events to foster knowledge transfer and provide valuable networking opportunities for local farmers and food producers. One notable event is the MMSU Techno Showcase and Farmers' Forum held in January 2023, which highlighted agricultural and aquaculture innovations. This four-day event featured exhibits from local micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs), as well as research and development institutions, promoting technological advancements and the adoption of new agricultural practices.

Additionally, the International Conference on Sustainable Agri-vironment Education, Entrepreneurship, and Community Development held in March 2023 emphasized the importance of sustainable practices and strategic foresight in agriculture.

Another key initiative, the International Knowledge Systems for Community Management conference in May 2023, brought together experts to discuss the role of indigenous knowledge in modern agriculture.

These events, among others, enable farmers to connect with experts and gain essential insights into sustainable farming practices.
