Mariano Marcos State University builds new buildings to sustainable standards. (MMSU) prioritizes sustainable standards in its new constructions, as demonstrated by the recently inaugurated buildings for the College of Computing and Information Sciences (CCIS) and the Coastal Engineering and Management Research and Development Center (COASTER). The CCIS building supports a smart campus initiative with advanced XR equipment and hyflex classrooms that minimize resource consumption while enhancing digital and ICT education.

Similarly, the COASTER building, developed in partnership with the Department of Science and Technology, includes state-of-the-art facilities for coastal engineering research aimed at disaster resilience. This building supports sustainable goals through specialized laboratories and resources that drive coastal disaster-risk reduction and resilient community planning.
