MMSU College of Industrial Technology: Then and Now

Mariano Marcos State University - College of Industrial Technology (MMSU-CIT) which offers Bachelor of Industrial Technology (BSIT) as one of its curricular programs is situated along the SIRIB MILE, considered as the new university belt of Laoag City. The campus is exactly located at the corner of P. Gomez St. and Giron St. that is covered by Brgy. 5, Laoag City. The northern part of the area is bounded by an irrigation canal beside the proposed Provincial Library; Giron St. on the eastern part; Ilocos Norte National High School (INNHS) along Ablan Ave on the west; and P. Gomez St. the south where the Shamrock Elementary School and Norther Christian College were also located. The three road boundaries of the campus are essential to students, faculty and visitors because they provide ease and accessibility to public transport and roadways. The college is also accessible to people coming from nearby and distant municipalities in the province of Ilocos Norte, Cagayan and Ilocos Sur. The Manila North Road which is the major route to all public utility bus and vehicles is just six hundred meters (600m) away from the campus via P. Gomez St. The 29,922 sq. m. campus is surrounded with private dormitories and apartments apart from its own dormitory that provide housing to faculty and students. Educational related businesses and work stations are also established within the boundary of the school making it more convenient to students.



The total area of the campus is where the seven (7) building of the college is sited. (1) The Academic Building; (2) Administration Building; (3) Science Building; (4) Automotive Technology Building; (5) Technology Bldg. and (6) Ceramics Technology Bldg; (7) Student Lounge and ASUL.

A portion of the DTI Bldg. at the Ferdinand E. Marcos Sports Complex Marcos Stadium) was also awarded to MMSU-CIT by the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) to be utilized by Physical Education (PE) Classes. It is a two-storey building that has two classrooms and can accommodate 50 students per classroom. The open ground of the campus serves as a parking space for employee, students and visitors vehicle. The remaining portion of the open ground also serves as an access road inside the campus.

Currently, the MMSU - College of Industrial Technology is taking huge step in campus development. The Provincial Government of Ilocos Norte has already awarded the lot with an area 29,922 sq. m. to MMSU. From this, the MMSU Administration released a fund amounting 36 million pesos for the construction of the new academic bldg. that has 16 classroom and 4 comfort rooms and next year an initial fund amounting to 20 million pesos was also allocated for the construction of the Administration - Science Building.
