

Access to university track underrepresented groups applications

One of the services being offered by the Student Welfare Unit under the Office of Student Affairs and Services (OSAS) of the University is Inventory Services which include the collection of information about the students' personal/educational, health conditions and other social data needed to fully understand the student using the **Cumulative Records of Students (CuReS)** form which can be accessed online by all students through their portals. Through the CuReS which can be accessed by the Guidance Counselors, the University can measure and track applications and admissions of underrepresented (and potentially underrepresented) groups including ethnic minorities, low income students, non-traditional students, women, LGBT students, disabled students, and newly settled refugee students. Below is a sample screenshot of a CuReS form on the student's portal.
