SDG 12 | RESPONSIBLE PRODUCTION AND CONSUMPTION

MMSU helps ensure that responsible and sustainable production and consumption is integrated in its operation by implementing sustainable agriculture, processing, and waste and pollution management programs. Notably, in 2024, students actively engaged in campaigns against single-use plastic, promoting the use of reusable water bottles, minimizing plastic waste and enabling responsible management of resources.

Since 2010, MMSU has been using its collected biomass wastes to produce commercial-grade organic soil since the institution views the organic wastes as a valuable resource. The university's signature technology for promoting the production of organic soil is vermicomposting. Over the years, MMSU has been used as a knowledge and talent base in the province, assisting LGUs in developing their organic soil production potential.
