MMSU institutes programs policies to combat climate change and its impacts. It remains at the forefront of battling climate change through innovative initiatives, such as launching the Climate Health-Competence Center, the first of its kind in the Philippines, and organizing public events that harmonize climate action across various sectors.

It also had its annual tree planting that underscores the university's commitment to environmental sustainability and creating a greener future by enhancing micro-climate zone in the university campuses. Moreover, it encouraged it personnel to join international conferences (29th Conference of the Parties or COP29) and partner with local and international organizations (DOST, UP-Manila) that tackle climate change. A workshop on the Climate Information Services-Community of Practice (CIS-COP) was also conducted to strengthen community-based approaches in climate information services and health.
