MMSU Follows Regional Daily Minimum Wage Rate

As a government institution, MMSU abides by the Salary Standardization Law (SSL) in determining the pay rate and paying the wages of faculty and staff. For regular employees, the SSL is strictly implemented; hence, salary rates for regular employees are higher than the minimum wage rate prescribed in the Regional Wage Order of the Regional Tripartite Wages and Productivity Board I (RTWPB). For non-regular employees, the lowest wage paid to a Job Order worker was Php 402 based on DOLE-National Wages and Productivity Commission Wage Order Number RB 1-22 effective October 10, 2023.
