

SDG 10 I REDUCE INEQUALITIES

MMSU commits to contribute to the reduction of inequality and help ensure that no one is left behind in development. It continues to expand its services to include and provide access to more sectors. Notably, it initiated a partnership with the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (BJMP), extending health and wellness services to people deprived of liberty, among others. The partnership initiates a movement to uplift the marginalized, amplify their voices, and uphold the fundamental right to health for all. It also recognized learners with special needs by holding a seminar for inclusivity. Lastly, to help meet the essential needs of students and employees, the College of Agriculture, Food, and Sustainable Development launched its Free Store where it offers free essential items such as clothing, school supplies, books, food, and other basic needs for anyone in need. The free store has already served more than 300 students who are from the low-income family.
