HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL

Mariano Marcos State University (MMSU) upholds its longstanding policy on the disposal of hazardous wastes across the campus. In 2020, the MMSU Integrated Waste Management Program was revised to offer a more comprehensive approach to pollution and waste management, incorporating hazardous materials. The updated policy mandates that all hazardous wastes on campus be properly stored and labeled before collection. Additionally, the policy requires the establishment of a centralized storage facility for Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs) and other hazardous or toxic wastes. The university also registers all facilities that generate hazardous wastes.

Hazardous wastes are handled separately for proper hauling and segregation. These wastes are temporarily stored in designated facilities for up to one year before final disposal. The university coordinates with the Environmental Management Bureau of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources for the final collection and disposal of these materials.
