It also focuses on promoting ecological care and protection. As such, the plans adhere to local codes, policies, and regulations related to land use, zoning, and waste management.

Additionally, the university's R&D agenda is aligned with the sustainable use, conservation, and restoration of land. Various projects are focused on biodiversity assessment in urban forests and green spaces, as well as conducting research on sustainable forest management, conserving and enhancing local genetic resources, and maximizing their benefits.
