Key Activities and Accomplishments

Build, Strengthen and Expand Partnerships

- Academic Partnership. Twelve students from Ashikaga University in Tochigi, Japan, are participating in a 10-day Special English Language Program at Mariano Marcos State University (MMSU) on February 28. Among them, eight are nursing students, and they will be mentored by faculty from the College of Arts and Sciences. This program focuses on a grammar-based conversational approach, allowing the students to enhance their English language skills through lectures, small group discussions, and cultural immersion activities, including visits to notable tourist sites in llocos Norte. Through this experience, the students not only improve their language proficiency but also deepen their understanding and appreciation of Ilocano culture. The MMSU Language Center, responsible for non-credit language education, facilitates the program, continuing the partnership between MMSU and AU, which began in 2018 to promote research, academic initiatives, and competitive training for nursing and engineering students.
- O Global Partnership Summit. In its ongoing effort to expand international linkages, Mariano Marcos State University (MMSU) participated in the fourth Annual Global Partners Summit hosted by Seirei Christopher University (SCU) Global Committee in Japan on February 21. MMSU was among eight universities in the virtual meeting, which focused on international exchanges, post-pandemic collaboration, and admissions for international students. Representing MMSU, Prof. Sucgang highlighted the university's international exchange program with SCU, particularly the two-week clinical externship for five Japanese physical therapy students in Ilocos Norte. He also shared plans to strengthen ties with SCU's nursing and pharmacy programs and expressed hopes for further partnerships in health sciences with other foreign universities. Institutions from Singapore, the United States, China, and Thailand also participated in the summit, marking the second time MMSU attended this event.

- International Exchange Program. Five physical therapy students from Seirei Christopher University (SCU) in Japan undergo a clinical externship at Mariano Marcos State University (MMSU) on February 20, as part of the ongoing international exchange program between the two institutions. Facilitated by MMSU's College of Health Sciences (CHS) Department of Physical Therapy, the students were placed in various health facilities, including the University Physical Therapy & Rehabilitation Center, Mariano Marcos Memorial Hospital and Medical Center (MMMH&MC), Black Nazarene Hospital Institute, and Laoag Rehabilitation and Physical Therapy Center in Ilocos Norte. They also participated in the university's community-based rehabilitation project for differently-abled children at Florentino Camaquin Integrated School (FCIS) in Vintar. This program stems from the 2021 memorandum of understanding signed by MMSU President Shirley C. Agrupis and SCU President Shohei Ohgi to enhance collaboration in health sciences through exchanges of faculty, scholars, and academic resources.
- Faculty Mobility Program. Dr. Charlie Batin, associate professor of the Mariano Marcos State University (MMSU) College of Agriculture, Food, and Sustainable Development (CAFSD), qualified for the Southeast Asian University Consortium for Graduate Education in Agriculture and Natural Resources (UC) Faculty Mobility Program this year. From June 1 to August 31, 2023, Dr. Batin, who also chairs the CAFSD Department of Forestry and leads MMSU's Bamboo Research and Development Program, participated in the program at Tokyo University of Agriculture (Tokyo-Nodai), Japan. Funded by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) through SEARCA's "Leveling-Up Philippine Higher Education Institutions on Agriculture, Fisheries, and Natural Resources" project, Dr. Batin engaged in research, delivered lectures, and developed a potential collaborative research proposal between MMSU and Tokyo-Nodai.
- Joint Webinar Series on Multiculturalism. Mariano Marcos State University (MMSU) enhanced multicultural appreciation and creativity by partnering with Universitas PGRI MADIUN (UNIPMA) in Indonesia for the Artes Y Letras 2023 webinar series on language and humanities. Held in February, the event, titled Multicultural Creativity and Appreciation in Education, explored the literature, languages, poetry, songs, and stories of both the Philippines and Indonesia. Organized by the MMSU Internationalization, Linkages & Partnership (ILP) Directorate and its UNIPMA counterpart, the sessions aimed to promote cultural awareness and mutual learning through vibrant cultural performances, engaging Filipino and Indonesian students alike.
- Access on Film and Media Resources. To support the promotion of locally-made media materials, the Provincial Government of Ilocos Norte (PGIN) granted Mariano Marcos State University (MMSU) the authority to utilize PGIN-produced films and other audio-visual content for educational purposes. During the kick-off of Ilocos Norte's 205th Foundation Anniversary Celebration on February 2, Governor Matthew Marcos Manotoc handed over the certificate of award to MMSU President Shirley C. Agrupis at the Provincial Capitol Building in Laoag City. This certificate allows the university free access to various media products, including films from the Tan-Ok ni Ilokano Festival, documentaries, tourism marketing materials, and PGIN-produced music, which can be used for academic activities.
- MMSU International Friendship Day Celebration. The International Friendship Day program of the Mariano Marcos State University brought together its students and 17 international graduate students from Japan, Zimbabwe, the USA, China, and India, on March 10, at the Center for Flexible Learning. Organized by the Language Center and the International Linkages and Partnership Directorate, the event aimed to strengthen cross-cultural ties within the university. Foreign students from Seirei Christopher University and Ashikaga University in Japan were joined by students from Zimbabwe, the United States, India, and China. Traditional cultural performances by MMSU artists and showcases of international cultures by the foreign

- students, including song performances, a travel video, and traditional Filipino games, highlighted the event.
- Knowledge exchange in documentation, research and community engagement. Mariano Marcos State University hosted an International Conference on Prairie and Indigenous Knowledge in Agriculture, Education, Culture, and Health (PIKAECAH) on May 16, at the Teatro Ilocandia. The conference was organized by MMSU's Indigenous Knowledge System and Cultural Management program brought together over a hundred participants from member institutions of the PhilCanEduCon Magic 7+ and various state universities and colleges in the country. It was held in collaboration with the Commission on Higher Education-International Affairs Staff and the Embassy of Canada in the Philippines. The three-day blended conference aimed to facilitate knowledge exchange in research and community engagement documentation focuses on indigenous knowledge in agriculture and fisheries, research for development in education, agriculture, forestry, climate and environment, health, culture, and the arts. Research studies in these fields were presented during plenary and parallel sessions.
- MMSU Wins Global Citizenship Award at ICONS 2023. Reaping yet another fruit of its aggressive internationalization efforts, the Mariano Marcos State University bagged the Global Citizenship Award (SUCs and LUCs Category) in the Internationalization Champions of Nations Building and Sustainability (ICONS) Awards 2023 on October 6. MMSU President Shirley C. Agrupis received the award at the Philippine International Convention Center (PICC), together with Dr. Mee Jay Domingo, director for internationalization, linkages and partnerships. The university was also recognized for its feats in the World's Universities with Real Impact (WURI) 2023 and the Times Higher Education Impact Rankings (THE Impact), having ranked 101st-200th and 601st-800th, respectively. The awarding, hosted by the CHED International Affairs Services, recognizes exemplary Philippine colleges and universities that championed internationalization in Philippine Higher Education.
